- If three children in the same family are involved in the music program (including those at primary school and paying fees through ESC), the child with the lowest tuition fee will be exempt from tuition fees. Instrument hire if applicable will still need to be paid.
- Students learning two instruments are charged half the tuition fees for the instrument that is of the lesser amount. This does not include instrument hire.
- Regional funding for music staffing is dependent on students participating in an ensemble program. We offer an option for students to take music lessons without participation in ensembles. This fee reflects tuition costs without the subsidy that ensemble participation attracts.

FREE INSTRUCTION

- Schools provide students with free instruction and ensure students have free access to all items, activities and services that are used by the school to fulfil the requirements of the Curriculum. This includes the Victorian Curriculum F-10, the Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) including the VCE Vocational Major and the Victorian Pathways Certificate.
- Schools may invite parents to make a financial contribution to support the school.



PARENT PAYMENT REQUESTS

Schools can request contributions from parents under three categories:

Curriculum Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for curriculum items and activities which the school deems necessary for students to learn the Curriculum.

Other Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for non-curriculum items and activities that relate to the school's functions and objectives.

Extra-Curricular Items and Activities

Items and activities that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are above and beyond what the school provides for free to deliver the Curriculum. These are provided on a user-pays basis.

- Schools may also invite parents to supply or purchase educational items to use and own (e.g. textbooks, stationery, digital devices).



FINANCIAL HELP FOR FAMILIES

- Schools put in place financial hardship arrangements to support families who cannot pay for items or activities so that their child doesn't miss out.
- Schools have a nominated parent payment contact person(s) that parents can have a confidential discussion with regarding financial hardship arrangements.



SCHOOL PROCESSES

Your child will be using Edrolo as a core online and textbook VCE resource to support their studies in 2026. The following information outlines the key benefits of this resource for your child as they approach their final years at school, and how to pay for their online access via the Edrolo Payment Portal.

Payment must be made by Monday, 11th December 2025.

What is Edrolo?

Edrolo is a teaching and learning resource designed to offer 24/7 support to students. It consists of video theory lessons aligned to the study design, and is delivered by expert teacher-presenters. It also includes video solutions and sample answers to help students prepare for assessments and maximise their exam marks. Teachers will use the data from this to target support and make sure your child is on track with their studies throughout the year. Your child can access the course materials on Edrolo at any time, and also flag content to revisit or where they need extra support from their teacher. Edrolo is used by 95% of schools across Victoria, including the Top 20 performing high schools.

Your child might be asked by their teachers to use Edrolo for:

- prescribed holiday homework
- pre-class work
- post-class consolidation
- self-study, assessment preparation, and exam revision

6. Once you have signed into your account, click on the "**Pay now**" button in the top right-hand corner of your screen and follow the prompts.
