As we celebrate NAIDOC Week this week, I would like to acknowledge the traditional custodians of the land, here in Euroa, the Taungurung People and pay my respects to elders, past, present and emerging. We celebrate the stories, culture and traditions of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Elders of all communities who also work and live on this land.

Term 3 will once again be a busy term with many school events taking place. Our planning for 2023 is underway with the most important part of this the course counselling and subject selection process taking place with Year 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 students. Our Family/Student Information Evening is on Thursday 28 July and we look forward to seeing you in the school. There are changes to VCE and VCAL so it is important that you know about the new VCE courses.

We have scheduled our Student/Family/Teacher meetings for Tuesday 16 August from noon until 7.30pm. 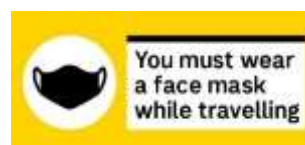
## School Bus

As per direction from PTV (Public Transport Victoria) the school bus service is not there to provide transport to get to after-school jobs, social or sports training etc. Any bus traveller who needs to make a “one off” request to change buses needs to give Mr Koutroubas a note signed by a parent/guardian on the morning of the day of such a request. Be mindful that the answer may have to be “no”.

The Violet Town Bus is full, there can be no “one off” requests for this bus.

Parents driving their students to school are reminded that students should be dropped off and picked up at the Campbell Street entrance to the school, near the front gates.

**BUS FARE INCREASE** - To align with Public Transport Victoria's ticketing price increases, a small increase will be applied to the School Bus Program's fare for ineligible travellers. This change represents the first increase in the School Bus Program's fare price since 2016. The new fare is \$125 per term (\$500 per year) which is an increase of \$5 per term (\$20 per year). The fare increase will take effect from the beginning of Term 2, 2022
