## Nagambie Bus Travellers

The Strathbogie Shire have advised the College that:

“The Nagambie-Locksley Road will be closed to through traffic starting Monday 25 March.

The Charles Creek bridge is being renewed and the road realigned.

Expected completion date (weather permitting) will be end of July 2024.”



The Nagambie bus will need to take a detour during this time which will add 8 minutes to the current route, stops will not change & times in the morning will not change.

**Visitors to the College** - All visitors must sign in at the front Office.

Payments may be made by way of Cheque by post, EFT, BPay or Credit Card over the phone.

**Conveyance Allowance** - students who live 4.8 kilometres from their bus stop or the school (if they are not serviced by a bus and travel by car) may be eligible for conveyance allowance. Forms can be obtained from the Office.

**School Bus** - As per direction from PTV (Public Transport Victoria) the school bus service is not there to provide transport to get to after-school jobs, social or sports training etc. Any bus traveller who needs to make a “one off” request to change buses needs to give Mr Williams a note signed by a parent/guardian on the morning of the day of such a request. Be mindful that the answer may have to be “no”.

The Violet Town Bus is full, there can be no “one off” requests for this bus.



Parents driving their students to school are reminded that students should be dropped off and picked up at the Campbell Street entrance to the school, near the front gates.

**In the case of a Fire/Flood in the area:** Buses will not operate in the morning or afternoon if there is any bush fire/flood activity threat on the bus route (ie a burning fire). Staff will also be encouraged to remain onsite.
